We know of course that these commodities are actually on sale all the year round, though as Easter approaches they are much more prominently displayed and colourfully promoted. I wonder how long it will be before Christmas wrapping paper and Christmas trees will be on sale throughout the year!



There is something else which is available all the year round and indeed available for every year and for all time, and that is the message at the heart of Easter, and hot cross buns and Easter eggs are actually useful reminders of this. The cross on the bun reminds us of the extent of God's love for us that in his Son Jesus he was prepared to die for us. The egg is an ancient pagan symbol of rebirth and was taken over by Christianity symbolising Jesus' resurrection, which tells us that nothing can destroy God's love for us, not even death. Easter not only points to God's eternal love for us but also it offers us hope. Beyond all suffering and death, darkness and despair, there is always the possibility of new life and light.
